Recommendations:

- Consider how the use of sound (music or spoken word) could be used to enhance your claymation.
- I would encourage you to think about the angles which you are filming from so you get more of the set in view.
- Your PAPD was incomplete and missing a number of entries (space, line etc). Make sure you address all
 required sections.
- Make sure you complete all elements of the task as you did not complete your reflection.
- Make sure that you are using subject-specific vocabulary in your written responses.
